## Revisiting NEP:2020

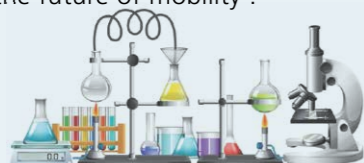

The 18 members of the junior students' council from classes II – V and 26 members of the senior students' council from classes VI – XII along with the eight school appointees were conferred with badges and sashes.

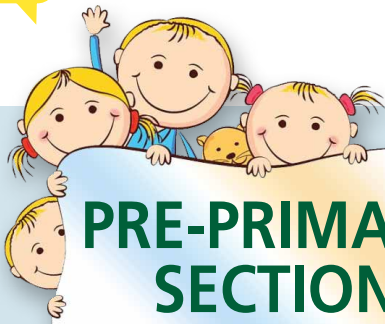


## Rabindra Jayanti
