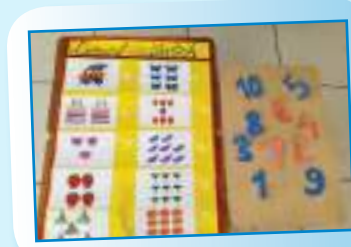
Admire the Artistry: Durga Puja Activity
