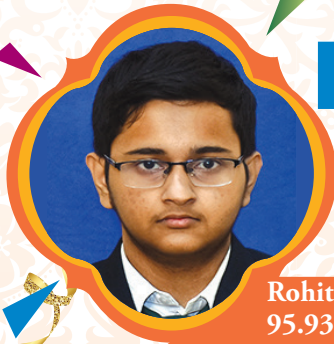

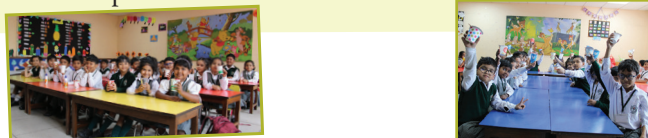
Thread painting activity: For the love of all things thread
